Proverbs 12

Further Study & Discussion

- Talk about v.1 and v.15. How important is it to be open for correction?
- If you are married, spend time talking about v.4 – for both “good wife” and “good husband.”
- If you know someone who is feeling anxious, reach out and be a “good word” of v.25.

Song of Solomon 2

Song of Solomon is filled with poetry and romance. Symbolically, we see Jesus’ love for his church.

Further Study & Discussion

- Talk about how this chapter reflects Jesus and his church. How is this like his second coming?

Galatians 3

Galatians is one of Paul’s earlier letters. In it, he makes an argument against salvation by one’s works and for salvation through faith in Jesus Christ.

Further Study & Discussion

- This chapter can be confusing, but what does Paul mean by the “curse of the Law” (v.13)? How can God’s Law become a curse for us? And what did Jesus do to break that curse?
- How are we connected to Abraham as he offspring (v.29)?
- How was the Law like a disciplinarian (v.24)? What does this mean?
